

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

RE: Midstate College-Robert Morris University-Illinois Teach-Out Agreement
In lieu of the impending closure of Midstate College, Robert Morris University-Illinois has made a
commitment to facilitate the teach-out of Midstate College's transitional students at our downtown
Peoria campus. This partnership is formed in an effort to best serve the Midstate students that are
currently enrolled and affected by the teach-out, by providing a viable, local option for completion of
their respective degrees..

Robert Morris University-Illinois has agreed to meet the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Robert Morris University-Illinois' Peoria campus is able to fully support the teach-out of AAS-BA, BBA, and MBA-MGT; the campus has enough room to accommodate all 67 students who are currently enrolled in these degree programs at Midstate College.
- 2. Although RMUI's programs are not available in a full-online platform, the students are afforded the option to take select classes online throughout each degree level.
- 3. The total number of quarter hours for the AAS-BA (92) and MBA-MGT (56) degrees are exactly the same at both Midstate College and Robert Morris University-Illinois. The BBA program at RMUI is 2 additional quarter hours (188), but will not require additional courses to be completed, above and beyond the number of courses left for completion at Midstate College.
- 4. With the teach-out, Robert Morris University-Illinois has agreed to match Midstate's current academic year tuition for any transitional student through September 2021, will be in full acceptance of all credit hours earned as a Midstate student, and will ensure that each student is required to take the very least amount of classes for degree completion in the teach-out agreement.

Midstate Director of Business Administration, Nick Fowler, has agreed to assist in the dissemination of all pertinent Robert Morris University-Illinois information and materials in order to provide clear and accurate teach-out information to the affected students at the earliest possible time.

Signees agree their organizations are able to honor all criterion outlined in this document.
